Dr. Lisa A. Castlebury is currently a research mycologist with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Agricultural Research Service (ARS) Systematic Mycology & Microbiology Laboratory (SMML) in Beltsville, Maryland. A native of Illinois, Dr. Castlebury earned her BS in 1988 and MS in 1991 in Biological Sciences from Western Illinois University, and received her PhD in 1994 in Plant Pathology from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Dr. Castlebury was a postdoctoral fellow with the Food & Drug Administration's (FDA) National Center for Toxicological Research (NCTR) in Jefferson, Arkansas, a research associate with USDA ARS in Beltsville, Maryland, and a plant pathologist with the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) prior to joining ARS in her current position in 1999. Dr. Castlebury's research expertise is the systematics and identification of plant-associated fungi.
